## IMPORTANT SAFETY INFORMATION

Do not use if you have had an allergic reaction to LEQVIO or any of its ingredients.

The most common side effects of LEQVIO were: injection site reaction (including pain, redness, and rash), joint pain, and chest cold.

## WHAT IS LEQVIO?

LEQVIO (inclisiran) is an injectable prescription medicine used along with diet and other cholesterol-lowering medicines in adults with high blood cholesterol levels called primary hyperlipidemia (including a type of high cholesterol called heterozygous familial hypercholesterolemia [HeFH]) to reduce low-density lipoprotein (LDL-C) or "bad" cholesterol.

## How to get your LEQVIO® injection at an Alternate Site of Care (ASOC)

Your doctor will contact the ASOC and send them your information.

### Then, an ASOC coordinator will:

01

#### Call you.

The ASOC coordinator will call you from an unknown number. Make sure to answer the call and have your insurance information ready.

02

#### Verify your insurance.

The ASOC coordinator will perform a benefits investigation/verification to determine your out-of-pocket cost, if any, and provide information on any co-pay assistance programs.

03

#### Schedule your appointment.

The ASOC coordinator will schedule your LEQVIO appointment. Two visits may be required—one as an initial visit for assessment and another to receive your first LEQVIO injection.



**Keep working together with your doctor. They will still oversee your treatment.**
